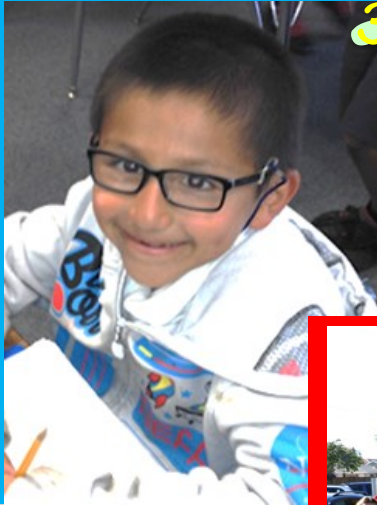

### WHAT ARE THE DAYS & HOURS OF PROJECT SUCCESS?

**PROJECT KIDZ CONNECT** is a Monday-Friday program that begins each school day at dismissal time and runs until 6pm. We start the first day of school and end on the last. We are closed during holidays and non-school days, according to the NMUSD calendar.

### WHO CAN ATTEND PROJECT SUCCESS?

Students attending any of our nine school are eligible to enroll in **PROJECT KIDZ CONNECT**. Please refer to the back of this brochure for a list of participating schools.

### HOW DO I APPLY FOR PROJECT SUCCESS?

Parents can request an application from their child's teacher or in the front office. Teachers and school staff can also refer students to the program at any time during the school year.

### HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

We are funded by a grant from the California Department of Education. This grant allows us to offer the program free of charge to students that attend school at one of our nine sites.
